### Notice

As recommended by AICTE vide No.(1) Acad/(AIB)/ status of Syllabi/2012/245 dt 25/4/2014 [for Environmental Studies] and (2) ACADEMIC/UG/DM/1/2009/373dt 19/6/2014 [for Disaster Management] and subsequently resolved in the meeting of the Board of Studies of West Bengal State Council of Technical Education on 07/08/2014, two( 2) subjects namely (1) Environmental Studies and(2) Disaster Management will be introduced in Diploma level curriculum. Environmental Studies and Disaster Management to be included in diploma curriculum in 3rd semester and 4<sup>th</sup> semester in the academic session 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively as a compulsory papers (examination to be conducted internally). The students of Agricultural Engg., Mine Surveying, Chemical Engg., Food Processing Technology and MOPM are not required to study Environmental studies separately since the subject is already included in their curriculum as a compulsory paper. The students of “Civil Engineering” need not study “ Disaster Management’ separately since it is already included in the curriculum.
