Sub: Changes in Examination Regulation for the 3 Years Fulltime Diploma Courses in Engineering & Technology

Dear Sir / Madam,

This is to inform you that the following changes in Examination Regulation for the 3 Years Fulltime Diploma Courses in Engineering & Technology were under active consideration of the Board of Studies and Board of Examinations of the West Bengal State Council of Technical Education for sometime past. After careful consideration, the Boards have given their approval for implementation of the following changes in the Examination Regulation for the students who admitted in the academic session 2012-2013.

- The marks pattern for the theoretical subjects will be as follows:–

For Full Marks: 100

- Internal Assessment: 25
- Theoretical Examinations: 75

For Full Marks: 50

- Internal Assessment: 12
- Theoretical Examinations: 38

- The Pass marks in each theoretical paper shall be 40% of the full marks in that paper and pass marks in each sesssional paper shall be 50% of the full marks in that paper.
- Students being awarded a Diploma shall be placed in the: –
 - First Class with Distinction provided they have passed all the subjects in one chance obtaining at least 75% of the Overall Marks;
 - First Class provided they have obtained at least 60% of the Overall Marks;
 - Second Class provided they passed all the subjects of all semesters obtaining less than 60% of the overall marks.


- The overall marks of a successful student in the entire course of study shall be calculated in percentage in the following way: –
 - For all Full-Time Diploma courses, other than Modern Office Practice & Management and Pharmacy, Overall % of marks = 20% of marks obtained in Part – I + 40% of marks obtained in Part – II + 40% of marks obtained in Part – III.
 - For Modern Office Practice, Overall % of marks = 33-% of marks obtained in Part – I + 33-% of marks obtained in Part – II + 33-% of marks obtained in Part – III.
 - For the students who admitted through Lateral Entry Scheme in the 2nd year class, Overall % of marks = 50% of marks obtained in Part – II + 50% of marks obtained in Part – III.
- Grade system will be introduced instead of providing marks in marksheets. Overall Grade Point will be provided in the marksheet by shifting decimal point to one digit left of percentage marks. The Grade Scores for the individual subjects as well as for Overall Percentage will be as follows:–

O (Outstanding)	= 85% and Above
E (Excellent)	= 75% to Below 85%
G (Good)	= 60% to Below 75%
S (Satisfactory)	= 50% to Below 60%
M (Moderate)	= 40% to Below 50%
F (Failed)	= Below 40%

The modified Examination Regulation incorporating aforesaid changes will be available in the Council's Website in due course.
