NOTIFICATION

The Government of West Bengal has been carrying out interventions in the field of skill development for some time. Non-institutional short term interventions with pan India certifications are emerging as increasingly relevant to the skilling needs of the State considering the inherent flexibility in terms of location, number of hours of training as well as engagement hours resulting in greater acceptability.

WHEREAS, during the course of these interventions, it has been observed that regional imbalances in short term training opportunities across the state is a potential impediment in delivery of skill training in the far flung areas including comparatively inaccessible rural and difficult/hilly areas of the State:

WHEREAS, it has been felt that there is a need for improving the outreach of relevant training programmes in such areas of the state: AND

WHEREAS, there is a good number of Training Providers in the state to provide relevant non-institutional short term training programs having the required domain expertise to impart such relevant skill training in terms of Trainers, equipments, tools, implements and learning resources which are concentrated in comparatively accessible areas resulting in highly skewed distribution of their Training Centres with many blocks being totally unrepresented: AND

WHEREAS, there are good numbers of Public institutions viz. Govt. ITIs, Polytechnics, VTCs, other Training Institutions conducting training programs, available in the State leading to a potentially wide high outreach for Skill Development programmes.

NOW, WHEREAS, it is necessary to expand the outreach to the far flung areas interiors of the State built on the flexible architecture that enables optimal infrastructure utilization leading to equitable access resulting in greater opportunities for people in remote areas to gain training opportunities in non-institutional short term interventions:

THEREFORE, the Governor is pleased to order that.

- a) Empanelled Training Providers would be permitted to use the space in Public institutions viz. Govt. ITIs, Polytechnics, VTCs and other Training Institutions for Skill training impartation programmes under various Government interventions without disturbing the normal working of these Institutions.

- b) Physical infrastructure like building etc. along with access to electricity, water etc. shall be provided by the Government, while the Training Providers would be responsible for provisioning for all requisite Trainers, equipment, tools implements and learning resources to impart training as well as take care of all recurring costs.
- c) For these purposes, a user fees, called as **User Charge Deducted at Source (UCDS)**, would be charged @10% of the training cost. This UCDS would be deducted from the training charges payable to Private Training Providers by the Training sponsoring Department and shall be deposited to the following dedicated Receipt Head of Accounts that has been created for the purpose :


“0202- Education, Sports, Art and Culture -02-101 – Tuitions and other fees-005- User charges deducted at source from the Private Training Providers-27- Other Receipts”.

- d) The expenditures from this head shall be from the Expenditure Head of Account **“2203 - Technical Education -00-003- Training- NP- Non Plan- 005- Skill Development Training Programmes - 31 - Grants-in-aid – 02 - Other Grants”**. Funds under this dedicated expenditure Head of Accounts shall be utilized to meet costs of assessments and incidental expenditures for national level certification (Assessment by NCVT/NSDC Sector Skills Councils etc.) for all State Government sponsored short term training interventions and other similar activities.

This order is issued with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. No. Gr.T/2015-16/0553 dated 06.10.2015 and U.O number Gr. N/2310 dated 7.12.2015 read with U.O number Gr. N/2404 dated 11.12.2015.

This has also got the approval of the Cabinet vide its decision No. 2441 dated 16.11.2015.


